

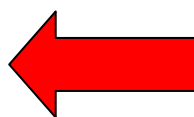
A SNAPSHOT - TE KAVEINGA NUI NATIONAL SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2011-2015

The National Vision

To enjoy the highest quality of life consistent with the aspirations of our people in harmony with our culture and environment



Outcome 1: Sustainable economic growth in harmony with our social values, culture & environment

Outcome 2: Well educated, healthy & productive people & resilient communities

Outcome 3: Enhanced Cultural and Environmental values

Outcome 4: Responsible & mature foreign relations with New Zealand & other regional and international communities in the interest of the people of the Cook Islands

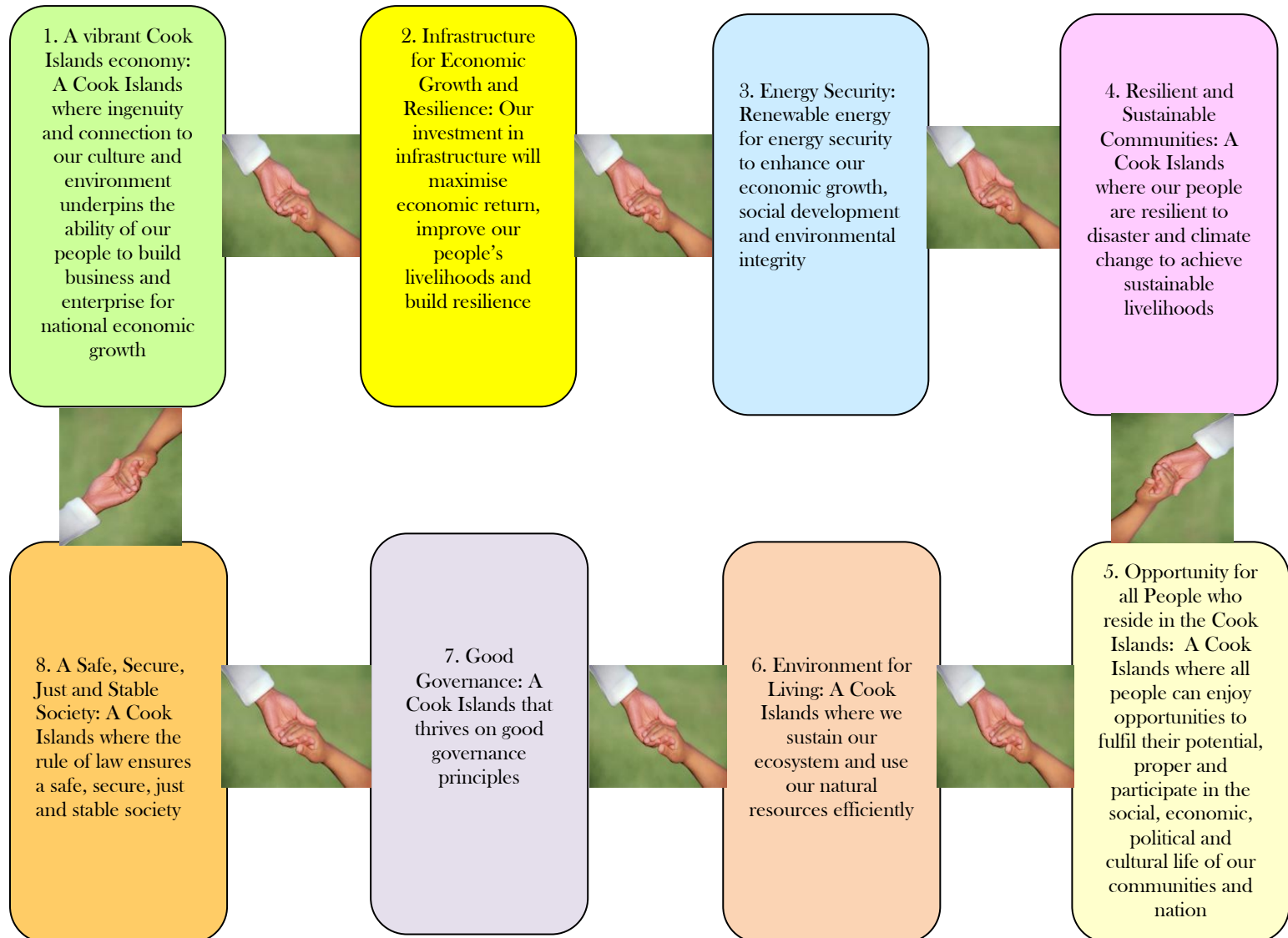
Outcome 5: A secure society built on law & order & good governance
